



Catalyst 1.0 Release Notes: Oct 6, 2009

What's in Catalyst 1.0

Collaboration

Shared, secure workspaces	Store and organize your maps and other files in one or more workspaces. Invite users to your account with access options that allow you to control which workspace each user can access and edit. You can also grant individual users the ability to create their own workspaces within your account.
Web conferencing (add-on)	Initiate an unlimited number of meetings with up to 15 members each. Supports video, VoIP, file transfers, session recordings, and full desktop sharing. Requires Windows browsers (or Macs running Windows environments.)
Co-edit maps	Edit maps with multiple users in your workspace. You're free to modify ideas in one area of a map, while a colleague adds supporting details elsewhere.
Chat	Quickly exchange ideas with logged-in members of your workspace one-on-one; or launch a web conference to chat simultaneously with one or more web conference participants, even if they aren't members of your workspace.
Map sharing	Share a link to your map with your email contacts, blog readers, or post to networks like Facebook™, LinkedIn™, and Twitter™. Viewers can either view your map in a browser, or copy it for their own use, if you choose.

Highlights of the keyboard short cuts in Catalyst 1.0 web mapping

Note: Not all browsers support all shortcuts

- undo/redo: **Ctrl+Z/Y**
- cut/copy/paste: **Ctrl+X/C/V**
- multiple selection: **Shift+Left/Right/Up/Down**
- insert topic as previous sibling: **Shift+Enter**
- edit topic text: **F2**
- open **Add Hyperlink** dialog: **Ctrl+K**
- show/hide taskpane: **Ctrl+Shift+T**
- fit map: **Shift+F5**
- focus on topic: **Shift+F3**
- next level of detail: **Ctrl+Shift+D**
- toggle **Notes** panel open/closed: **Ctrl+Shift+N**
- make topic bold: **Ctrl+B**
- make topic italic: **Ctrl+I**
- make topic underline: **Ctrl+U**



- remove topic: **Ctrl+Shift+Delete**
- scroll map: **Ctrl+Left/Right/Up/Down**
- scroll map by page: **PgUp / PgDn**
- insert callout: **Ctrl+Shift+Enter**
- move topic up/down: **Ctrl+Alt+Up/Down**
- create callout: **Ctrl+Shift+Enter**
- add boundary: **Ctrl+Shift+B**

Catalyst 1.0 Known Issues

Issue: Drawing differences between desktop and web versions.

Workaround: None. Mindjet has worked hard to maintain a high degree of fidelity between a map displayed in MindManager and MindManager Web. However, there will be subtle differences in spacing, margins, lines, color, etc. between maps displayed in MindManager and MindManager Web. These differences, however, should not take away from accurately representing the content of the map.

Issue: Creating new secondary documents with MindManager 7.2 & 8.0 desktop clients and opening these empty documents via Web mapping 2.0 can cause various error messages to be displayed.

Workaround: If you create a new empty secondary document with MindManager 7.2 or 8.0, please update the contents of that document with some data by using either the check out / check in functionality of the MindManager 7.2 or 8.0 desktop client, or the replace document functionality of Web mapping 2.0, before attempting to open these documents with Web mapping 2.0.

Issue: Users may experience erratic scrolling in Web mapping if multiple users are changing the layout of the same map

Workaround: None.

Issue: There may be inconsistencies with the presence indicator showing other users' status in the map you are currently working on.

Workaround: None.

Issue: Microsoft Office export features not supported.

Workaround: None. MindManager for Windows desktop client may be used to export maps into Microsoft Office formats.



Issue: **MM Web cannot be launched in Microsoft Internet Explorer when the browser's security level is set to High or Medium High.**

Workaround: Adjust the browser's security level to Medium or lower (Go to Tools>Internet Options).

Issue: **Notes with tables that were created with MindManager Pro are not editable and only show up in a separate window. Notes with images that were created with MindManager Pro are not editable. The images are also not visible and are replaced with placeholders.**

Workaround: Make sure you click on the table placeholder in the Notes view to see your tables in a separate browser window.

Issue: **Adding and removing attachments are not supported in the undo/redo stack.**

Workaround: Undoing the attachment command currently works, but redoing doesn't. The issue is being investigated.

Issue: **Only the image formats .JPG, .GIF and .PNG are supported, even though the image upload dialog allows users to import any type of file.**

Workaround: Please be aware that only .JPG, .GIF and .PNG file formats are accepted by the web client. However, the image upload dialog has been modified to have a default file filter which only allows the supported image types.

Issue: **The map's zoom factor is not remembered and will be lost when the map closes.**

Workaround: Please be aware that the map's zoom factor will default to 100% every time it is re-opened.

Issue: **MindManager Web's "practical" map size limit is less than 500 topics.**

Workaround: Please be aware that adding more than 500 topics to a map causes performance degradation.

Issue: **MindManager Web's "practical" co-editing limit is around 10 users.**

Workaround: Please be aware that when more than 10 people co-edit a map at the same time, it causes some performance degradation.

Issue: **Activity hints don't always appear where a user actually modified the map.**

Workaround: None. The issue is being investigated.



Issue: **When adding attachments in MindManager Web, the attachment size is restricted to 2 MB.**

Workaround: To link to larger sized documents, import them as workspace documents first, and then hyperlink to the workspace document from within your map. Note that you can view maps with attachments up to 10MB in size if they were added using the MindManager desktop client.

Issue: **Documents that contain viruses get replaced by empty documents which cause errors when attempting to open them.**

Workaround: None. Even though Web mapping does not gracefully handle virus infected files, virus protection is enabled on the server and guarantees that no virus infected files are uploaded.

Issue: **Read-only or password protected maps can't be imported.**

Workaround: None. Please check the security setting of your map if you are not able to import it.

Issue: **Project Task Management roll up flag map markers from MindManager 8 do not appear in MindManager Web.**

Workaround: None. The issue is being investigated.

Issue: **Undo stops working after a Drag&Drop of at least a few hundred topics at once.**

Workaround: None. The issue is being investigated.

Issue: **When using Safari to run Web mapping and downloading an attachment with a foreign-language filename, the filename (not the contents of the file) will get corrupted.**

Workaround: Rename the file manually once it's downloaded.

Issue: **No support for topics created on the Tablet PC in pen mode. The topics appear, but are blank on the web client.**

Workaround: None.

Issue: **Web mapping is not able to print non-ASCII characters in header and footer regions of the map.**

Workaround: None.



Issue: **Web mapping will close if you are removed from a workspace and immediately try to access a map in that workspace.**

Workaround: None. The system didn't have time to remove that workspace from your list, even though it is now technically inaccessible to you.

Issue: **Pasting a large amount of text in the Notes window may cause Web mapping to stall and return a runtime error.**

Workaround: None. The issue is being investigated.

Issue: **Katakana entry doesn't work with Flash Player version 10.0.18.xx on Mac/Safari**

Workaround: Update to Flash player version 10.0.32.x or higher.

Issue: **Run time error occurs after refreshing shared map page that has been deleted**

Workaround: None. The issue is being investigated.

Issue: **Topic edits may be lost during co-editing.**

Workaround: Issue may occur when entering a large amount of text into a topic when others are creating new topics in the map. The issue is being investigated.

German language-specific Known Issues

Issue: **Message in English when flash is not installed.**

Workaround: If you see a page with English messaging, it is likely that you don't have Flash installed. Please go to www.adobe.com to install Flash.

Issue: **On German Browsers user sees blank page when Flash has never been installed or English error message when Flash is no longer available.**

Workaround: If you see a blank page, it is likely that you don't have Flash installed. Please go to www.adobe.com to install Flash.
